in Benazir case

ISLAMABAD — An Anti-Terrorism Court in Rawalpindi, Pakistan, has issued an arrest warrant against former president Gen. Pervez Musharraf (ret'd) in the Benazir Bhutto assassination case.

The court declared Musharraf a suspect in the interim chargesheet submitted by the prosecution. It held him part of a conspiracy to eliminate Benazir and setting up Taliban militant Baitullah Mehsud for the job.


The warrant was issued on the statements of Brig. (Retd.) Javed Iqbal Cheema, a spokesman of the Interior Ministry and Brig. Aijaz Shah, former director-general of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

EGYPTIAN ARMY COMMITS ITSELF TO ALL INTERNATIONAL TREATIES

CAIRO — Cairo's new military leadership on Saturday vowed to pave the way for democracy and abide by its peace treaty with Israel as Egyptians basked in their victory a day after Hosni Mubarak's overthrow.

The Supreme Council of the Armed Forces said the current government would remain in place for a peaceful transition to "an elected civil authority to build a free democratic state", though it set no timetable.
